



WELCOME TO PRUDHOE GOLF CLUB LADIES SECTION

From all at Prudhoe Golf Club a very warm welcome. We're delighted you have chosen to join us and we look forward to introducing you to our friendly members and staff. We have detailed below some information to help you enjoy your time with us.

The Ladies meet and have competitions on Wednesdays and Sundays. We have alternate day competitions for those unable to play in our Wednesday competition with allocated tee times on a Saturday.

Wednesday we have reserved tee times 10.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. (After Spring Clock Change)

Wednesday we have reserved tee times 10.30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. (After Autumn Clock Change)

Saturday - Alternative Day reserved tee times 2.00 p.m. to 2.30 p.m.

Sundays we have reserved tee times 12.30 p.m. to 1.30pm all year.

As a section , we hold both 9 hole and 18 hole competitions throughout the year.

Following the Autumn clock change, the Ladies meet in the locker room and there is a draw held 15 minutes before play on both Wednesday and Sunday. If you would like to play simply arrive and enter your intention to play by 10.15 a.m. on Wednesday and 12.15 p.m. on Sunday.

During the main golfing season April to October, competition entry sheets are placed on the notice boards in the locker room. All competitions are drawn and this takes place 1 week before the date of play. If for any reason you miss a draw you can add your name after the draw has taken place, but you are discouraged from doing this regularly.

Competition entry is by done electronically and can be done so either in the Pro shop, Lounge or Ladies Locker room where you will see there are screens available. (should the system be down please sign the diary which will be placed on the desk in the Ladies locker room.) This will be accepted as your competition entry.

Once you have played you will then enter your scores on either of the screens mentioned above and place your completed card in the designated Ladies competition box.

You can enjoy your social golf by booking a tee time using the BRS System. You will have been registered on the system when you joined.

To play in our competitions you will require a CONGU handicap. If you have played golf for some time and have transferred from another club, your handicap will be transferred when you inform them of your new Club. On transfer of your handicap Prudhoe will become your home Club. If you are a member of two Clubs you will be asked to nominate your 'Home Club'.

Should you be new to golf and don't have a CONGU handicap, don't worry! To obtain one all that is needed is that you play and put scores in for 54 holes. You can do this by playing the front 9 holes 6 times, or play 18 holes 3 times or even a mixture of the two. You must play with a member who has a handicap who will sign confirmation of your scores on a card dated and marked 'For Handicap' All ladies with a playing handicap have had to do this and the Ladies Committee will be more than happy to help you obtain your 1st playing handicap. So no need to be shy in asking!

For the more experienced golfer the Section currently compete in 2 County team competitions, the Shield matches which consist of a team of 7 playing 6 matches off scratch. We play 3 home and 3 away matches usually commencing at 1.30 p.m. between May & August.

We also play in the Evening League which consists of 5 players played over 9 holes. The Evening League matches are played off handicap. As the name suggest these matches start at 6.00 p.m. Some home and some away matches held between May & the end of July.

These matches are a great opportunity to play different courses and meet new people. Ask anyone who has played in any of the matches and they will tell you how enjoyable they are.

Our fixtures list will give you all the information you will need about the dates for both Ladies and Mixed golfing competitions. Keep a watchful eye on our notice boards for information as we also play a friendly mixed match with Hexham Golf Club.

Some of our competitions are also qualifying competitions for County & National events.

Should you require a locker, these are available to rent for £25.00 per year. Please ask the Lady Captain or Office Manager and they would be happy to arrange one for you

At the start of the Season, at Lady Captain's Drive In we usually have a relaxed meal and presentation following the 9 hole competition. We also have a presentation and meal following play on Lady Captain's Day. You will normally find the Ladies in the lounge after golf enjoying a chat over a refreshing drink or some lunch.

At the end of the Year we hold a Presentation Evening for all members, and you will be invited to attend the Ladies and Club's A.G.M.s

The Ladies Section have a Committee and its members will be happy to help you out with any queries you may have. Our Ladies section is warm and friendly, and we often hold social events and evenings out to local restaurants which are enjoyed by all. Details will be posted on the notice boards.

The Club often host numerous social events which can be good fun so watch the notice board in the main hallway for details.

I have no doubt that all the Ladies will make you feel very welcome and it won't be long before you are enjoying new friendships as well as all the benefits Prudhoe Golf Club can offer. Enjoy!
