



Tips on playing the course.

There are several places on the course where you can see the position of flags on subsequent holes:

- 1st tee for the 9th green.
- 1st green or 7th tee for the 8th.
- 3rd fairway for the 5th.
- 5th tee for the 7th.
- 10th tee for the 18th.
- 12th fairway for the 17th.
- 12th green for the 16th.

Prudhoe Golf course starts benignly enough, but holes 2,3 & 4 all present opportunities to spoil you card, so the first test is to get to the fifth tee still in the game!

1. Short Par 4 downhill. The trick is to hold the green. Path & penalty area over the green. Free drop off the path (dropping zone between 1st and 8th greens).
2. Par 4 OB right. Please wait for the group in front to ring the bell before you tee off, and please ring it when you get there.
3. Par 4 OB in the fields to the right. Fairway kicks towards the right as you approach the green. Please do not go into the field to collect lost balls. They are lost. 6th Tee has priority over your 2nd shot. Please be aware of 5th green behind tall trees on left of the fairway at the top of the hill.
4. Par 4 OB right in the park. Tricky sloping green back to front, try to stay short of the pin.

5. Short Par 4. (Tee next to the 7th green, which is a blind tee shot, so worth checking the position of the flag).
6. Best approach to the green is from the left side of the fairway. Short approach shots tend to fall towards the left-hand bunker.
7. Blind par 3 you viewed from 5th tee.
8. Par 4 downhill, same problem as the 1st, path and penalty area beyond the green, so try to hold the green. Free drop off the path (dropping zone between 1st and 8th greens).
9. Par 4 or 5 depending on which tee you play from. (Par 5 from red and yellow tees, yellows are in the corner, behind the white tees). Uphill and often into the prevailing wind.
10. Par 4 off the white & yellow tees; par 5 off the red. OB over the green.
11. Par 3. OB over the back, penalty area to the right. Dropping zone from the penalty area by the right bunker. 12th tee located over the road. (NB: please be aware, you will be walking in front of the 18th tee as you head to the 12th)
12. Par 4 slight dogleg right. Aim left of centre from tee. Elevated green protected in front by penalty area at the foot of the hill & deep rough at back of the green.
13. Par 3 uphill protected by bunkers front, left and right. OB beyond the green
14. Par 5. Needs a good drive. Rough down the right-hand side. Dogleg right to elevated green.
15. Par 3, OB right & long.
16. Par 4 Dogleg right, the better drive is to left hand side of fairway to avoid being blocked out.
17. Par 4 Dogleg left. Elevated tee, the ideal drive is either short of or past the single tree on corner for view of the green.
18. Par 4 whites & yellows; par 5 off the red tees. Uphill & often played into prevailing wind. OB on the practice area to the left. OB beyond green. A five is a good bogey to finish!
